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

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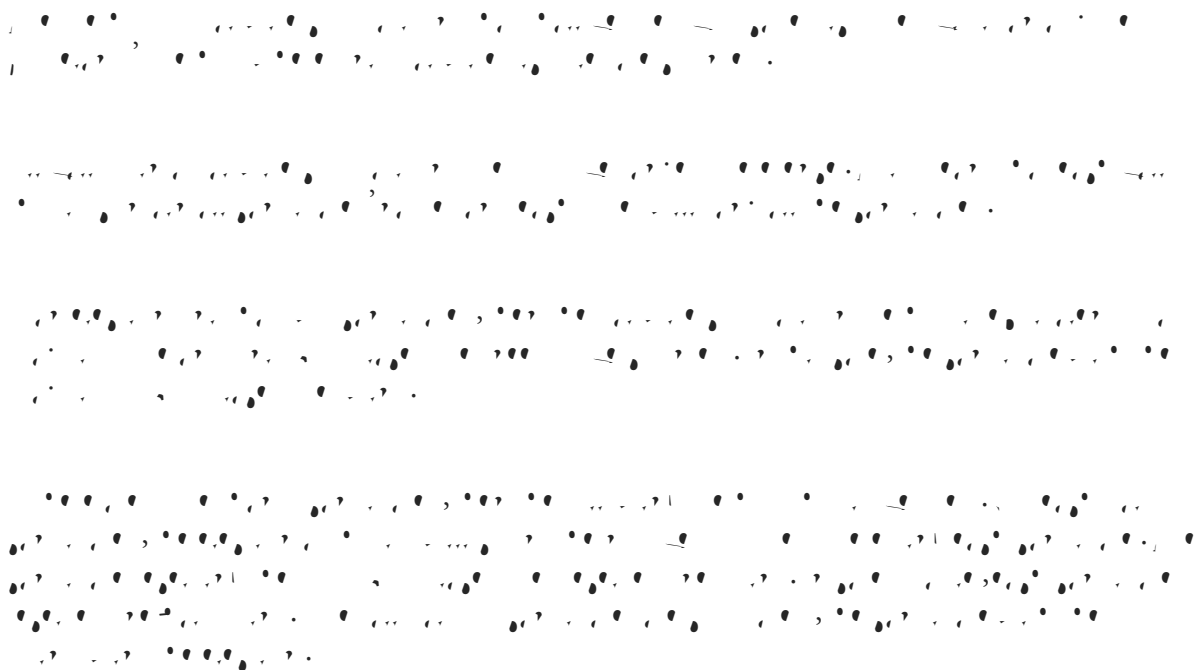

6. The Board shall have the authority to hire and fire the staff of the organization, and to set the salaries and benefits of the staff.

7. The Board shall have the authority to set the policies and procedures of the organization, and to monitor the performance of the staff.

8. The Board shall have the authority to amend the bylaws of the organization.

III. MEMBERSHIP

9. The organization shall have the right to accept donations of money and property from any individual or entity.

10. The organization shall have the right to accept membership from any individual who is at least 18 years of age and who is a resident of the community.

11. The organization shall have the right to accept membership from any individual who is a member of a church or synagogue in the community.

12. The organization shall have the right to accept membership from any individual who is a member of a fraternal organization in the community.

IV. MEETINGS

13. The Board of Directors shall meet at least once a month, and shall have the authority to call special meetings.

14. The organization shall have the right to hold public meetings, and to accept donations from the public.

15. The organization shall have the right to hold fundraisers, and to accept donations from the public.

16. The organization shall have the right to hold classes and programs for the children of the community.
